Went to church again Sunday night. It was mostly singing. We do anything we plan to get out of our area, which is only a couple of blocks long.

Tomorrow it will probably

be digging ditches or pouring
concrete, or cleaning the
barracks.

Monday they put me in
charge of 12 men to police,
clean up the regimental
area and scrub the
barracks, both upstairs
and down. The Lieutenant
came in and said it
was a good job, but I'm
afraid the boys thought
I worked them too hard.

There is a good chance that
I may get to be a squad
leader, which is a good job.
One gets out of a lot of little
details - such as K.P.

Guess this is about all
for now, Hon, I've got to
do some more work on
memorizing my general
orders.
