You had better come this week and make (?) up. You can bring the sugar with you or you can take the apples down home but I think that you had better make it up here. I can help you to make the apples up and stay up til Sunday and go to hear Doget preach. Tell Will to come with you and he can go to preaching every night.

Cold be with he and make up ap les up in and bee with me a 400 cant stay and set the obler us yo nea for me th berure and and get the ack aTA daggie the 1 loe 110 raid back and cone ley lo usall as well as comen w much low to yo ald

Aunt Rebecca said that she was going to come up this week and you could be with her and make up apples in butter and be with me (?).
