I am glad you got through your exam so well. Did you take your Trip to Washington D.C. ?

Letter to Bonnie from her grandmother Margaret (Maggie) Corell Graham. Letter not dated but probably around April 1942. Grandmother (Page 1) is Mary Rutledge Thompson Corell, who died May 17, 1942 (age 89). Maggie was probably in Tazewell for several months taking care of her mother.

Hope I will get home this summer in time for us to have that picnic Uncle Carter and Auntie were talking about. Guess it is most too soon to begin to think about picnic yet.
