Aug. 15<sup>th</sup> 1886

My Dear Ella and Mother

I have no news to write, but as I thought you would be looking for a letter from ~~me~~ <sup>me</sup> I will write any how. I stayed with Charley McNeil the night after I left home, & got to Uncle Joe's for dinner next day. Coz was up yesterday & stayed all day - she is getting right "chunky". We are going over to Graham next Sunday on our way to Danville, & will rent a house before we start on the train Monday. We can get a house from Geo. Hanson but we want to get one that will suit a little if we can. We have not decided whether we will move the office furniture, papers &c, over there before I go home to move, or whether we will move first, & then move office fixtures. I am at a loss to know who we will get to rent the place & take care of things when we leave. I have not heard any thing more from Mose Munsey.

Letter from WR Graham to his first wife Ella, and to his mother.
