## Letter from WR Graham to his wife Maggie.

Hunter Pulaski Alum Springs

Aug. 11, 1899

My Dear Wife:

I recd your letter this evening, and you don't know how glad I was to hear from you and to know that you and our precious little idols and mother were all well. I feel sorry that I did not bring you and the babies with me for I know that you would have enjoyed it very much. I think tho water is doing me a great deal of good.

Reba Ball is still here, and she is a very sick woman. She has female complaint or symptoms of appendicitis.

George and Jeff Gillespie all leave for home in the morning. The crowd has been thinning and very fast this week, and I don't think there are over 50 or 60 here now. They are expecting several more here next week.
