

Excerpts from two Leesburg newspapers published in early 1904 - "The Washington Mirror" and "The Record".

The Southern Railway ran between Washington, Alexandria and Bluemont - a 2½ hour trip leaving Bluemont at 6 and 11 am, 1:40 and 6:36 pm daily. Two others left from Leesburg.

A "Fine tire runabout" ready to hitch to a horse was advertised for \$65.

One hundred fifty acres was advertised for sale - 75 acres in grass, also timber and 150 fruit trees, well fenced, running water in every field - Nine room stone and frame building, stone barn, stabling for 9 horses, new cow barn for 26 cows, stone spring house, corn, carriage and ice houses, blacksmith and wheelwright shops, all in good condition. Convenient to RR station, church, school, post office and store - Price \$8,500.

New top buggy - \$43.50

Local paper - Featured ads from D.C. and Alexandria.

Jan. 4th - "Little rain - extreme cold - Ice houses filled, long-idled sleighs resurrected and sleigh bells constantly ringing".

Ad - Dr. T. A. Slocum offering 4 free large samples to anyone requesting a treatment that has permanently cured thousands of hopeless cases of consumption and all pulmonary complaints.
