




This Deed made this 16 day of August, AD 1892 between Chas O'Johnny Trustee as hereinafter mentioned party of the first part, and John Arnold party of the second part, both of Loudoun County Virginia Witnesseth that hereafter on the 13th day of October 1887 (Michael W Umbaugh and Mary A Umbaugh his wife by their deed of that date did convey the tract of land hereinafter more fully described to the said Chas O'Johnny) in trust to secure a bond for the sum of \$600 dated

Oct 1st 1887 executed by the said Michael W Umbaugh & payable one year after date to John Arnold and whereas default having been made in the payment of the said bond the interest thereon the said Trustee being) trustee required by the party) executed and having) duly advertised the said land according to law did proceed on 25 day of April 1892 in front of the Court House Leebury Va to sell the land aforesaid as which time to place the said John Arnold being the highest bidder became the purchaser of said land at the sum and price of \$16.05 per acre.

This deed therefore further witnesseth that in consideration of the purchase and of the payment of the purchase money aggregating the sum of \$856.26 the said Chas P Jamney Esq as aforesaid & the hereby grant and convey unto the said John Arnold to him and to his heirs and assigns forever all that certain tract of land in Leebury Dist in said County adjoining the lands of John W Brown George Umbaugh and others and according to a survey made on the 6th day of August 1892 by R H Stone Surveyor bounded as follows viz.
