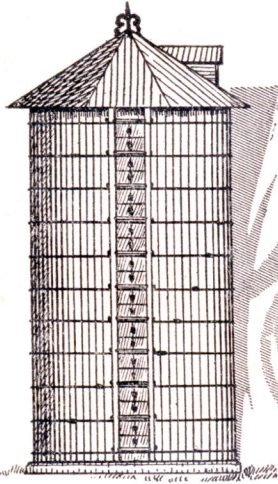

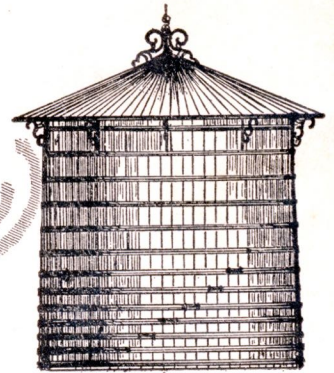

Dear Sir: Enclosed you will find bill of lading for Silo shipped you to Hamilton, Va. Please be careful in unloading same from the car to see that you get all the staves, bundles of hoops, etc. that your bill of lading calls for. You will please put the Silo in the dry after unloading, as should it get wet or damp, the lumber which is well seasoned would swell, and you would have considerable trouble in putting it together.

Enclosed you will find directions for erecting Silo, which you will please read and follow carefully, particularly the paragraphs in dark letters. The side of the staves which has the letter (H) marked on should be on the outside of silo.

Enclosed you will find invoice. Trusting Silo will reach you promptly and in good condition, we remain,
