Mary Graham Spring, Retired Loudoun School Teacher, Dies in Pennsylvania

Mrs. Mary Graham Spring, a retired school teacher with Loudoun County, died Oct. 24 in a York, Pa. nursing home. Mrs. Spring, 83, was a Purcellville resident.
