

# Ollie Monroe

Mrs. Ollie Graham Monroe, 72, of Leesburg, died Jan. 21 at the Sleepy Hollow Manor, Annandale, Va. where she had been a patient since October.

She was born in Tazewell, Va., being a daughter of William R. and Margaret Corell Graham. She was educated at the old Lincoln High School and the University of Virginia and taught school prior to her marriage.
